Event Task / Objective

Circuit Burn is a live stage roast battle where teams humorously critique, exaggerate, and creatively “burn” assigned tech topics, gadgets, or concepts.

The objective is to test wit, creativity, stage presence, spontaneity, and humor while keeping the content engaging and respectful.

Participants must deliver a high energy roast performance based on the topic given.

Event Format

Round 1: Topic Reveal

- Each team is assigned a tech topic randomly
- Examples:
 - Artificial Intelligence
 - Windows Updates

- Slow Internet
- Engineering Assignments
- Old Mobile Phones
- 10 minutes preparation time

Round 2: The Roast

- 3–4 minute live stage performance
- Teams must:
 - Roast the topic creatively
 - Include real tech references
 - Maintain humor without personal attacks
 - Engage the audience

Optional Twist Round:

Judges may introduce rapid fire “Burn Back” where teams respond instantly to counter jokes.



General Guidelines

- Content must remain respectful and non offensive.
- No personal attacks on individuals.
- Humor should focus on technology, trends, or situations.
- Use of props is allowed if arranged during prep time.
- Time limits must be strictly followed.



Submission Guidelines

- No pre written scripts allowed.
 - Preparation begins only after topic allocation.
 - Final performance must be delivered live.

Relevance to Topic	15%
Team Coordination	10%
Total	100 Points
