 **Event Task / Objective**

The **AI vs Human: Battle of Intelligence** event is designed to compare **human intelligence, creativity, and reasoning abilities** with modern **Artificial Intelligence tools**.

Participants will compete against AI in selected rounds to demonstrate that **human thinking, originality, and contextual understanding** can outperform AI-generated responses. The event aims to create awareness about AI tools, ethics, and real-world applications while making learning interactive and engaging.

 **Design / Technical Specifications**

- Participants will compete in knowledge, creativity, and logical reasoning tasks.
  - AI tools such as **ChatGPT or Google Gemini** will be used by the organizers for comparison.
  - Participants are **not allowed** to use AI tools during the event.
  - Internet access will be used only for AI demonstrations.
  - All tasks will be completed live during the event.
  - No pre-written answers or prepared materials are allowed.

## General Guidelines

- Participants must adhere strictly to the event schedule and time limits.
  - Participation can be individual or in teams of three.
  - All responses and solutions must be given **on the spot**.
  - Teams must clearly explain their approach wherever required.
  - Organizers will manage AI tools and display AI responses.
  - Any unethical behavior or misuse of technology will result in disqualification.

- This is a non-hardware, stage-based event.
  - Participants must follow auditorium safety and conduct rules.
  - No offensive, inappropriate, or unethical content is permitted.
  - Audience members must follow event instructions and remain orderly.
